PROTECTIVE PRECAUTIONS

Clean Hands before and after entering room

Visitors ~ See Nurse before entering



PATIENTS on STANDARD PRECAUTIONS

- Recovery after procedures can occur in general recovery area.
- Patient encouraged to stay in room, but permitted to leave room with a mask. Should remain in HEPA-filtered areas.
- NOT permitted to go outside the building.
- They should generally go to **private play/neutropenic time** in all child life spaces. They may be permitted to participate in select, small group activities that do not include patients with potential infectious process, but must wear a mask.

STAFF Caring for Patients on STANDARD PRECAUTIONS

- Clean hands upon room entry and exit, and any other time of possible contamination.
- Instruct families and visitors to clean their hands before entering and exiting the patient's room.

INDICATIONS for STANDARD PRECAUTIONS

- **Neutropenic** patients (ANC < 500 x 10⁶/L) on hematology/oncology service not meeting criteria for Strict Immunocompromised Precautions.
- BMT patients who are readmitted and have achieved T-cell reconstitution and are on minimal immunosuppressive therapy.
