



Requirements for all visitors: as of August 11, 2021, a California Department of Public Health (CDPH) order requires that all visitors show proof of COVID-19 vaccination and/or negative COVID-19 test results within 72 hours of visiting. To ensure our essential caregivers (parents, guardians, Birth Center partners) can visit more readily and participate in the care of their loved one, UCSF is providing COVID-19 testing on site. Once your loved one is settled into their room, you will be asked to go to the testing center via the first floor and outside to the right of the parking structure:

Mission Bay Testing is open Monday – Friday from 7am-7pm

If you have no symptoms of illness and your loved one does NOT have COVID-19, you can walk up for your initial test and then get scheduled for further testing dependent on your loved one's length of stay. If you do not hear from them, please call 415-476- 6407 to get your scheduled testing dates/times of either Monday/Thursday or Tuesday/Friday

Please bring your insurance card and wear your UCSF visitor ID sticker in a visible location. Upon arrival, you will be registered and will receive a Point of Care Test for COVID-19, which is a nose swab by our staff. A <u>negative</u> COVID-19 test will allow you re-entry to your loved one and you will be given a card with the results and the test date. Please take this card to the main lobby entry of the Children's Hospital and show it to guest services.

If your test is <u>positive</u>, you will require further testing and will be asked to NOT return to your loved one's bedside but rather to isolate outside the building whenever possible. The staff will give you further instructions and guidance.

UCSF strongly encourages all our caregivers to obtain a COVID-19 vaccination for the safety of yourself, your loved one and our staff. We provide free vaccinations to the public at the same site where you are obtaining your testing.

To get vaccinated at one of our clinics, please bring a valid ID.
