


All patients who have confirmed COVID, have signs/symptoms concerning for COVID and are undergoing evaluation (PUI), or have been exposed to a COVID case will require a Novel Respiratory Isolation Order.

The Isolation/Infection patient list column will display an icon for patients requiring the novel respiratory isolation order.

Guidance on selecting Novel Respiratory and Airborne Isolation:

- Novel Respiratory Isolation for COVID+ or symptomatic patient with suspected COVID with intermittent or no aerosol-generating procedures (AGPs)
- Both Novel Respiratory and Airborne Isolation for COVID+ or symptomatic patient with suspected COVID undergoing continuous aerosol-generating procedures, place in negative pressure isolation room (AIIR)

Which Isolation type should you order? Examples are below:

COVID+ or Symptomatic Patient with Suspected COVID Isolation options:

- Novel Respiratory Isolation** for COVID+ or symptomatic patient with suspected COVID with intermittent or no aerosol-generating procedures (AGPs)
- Both **Novel Respiratory** and **Airborne Isolation** for COVID+ or symptomatic patient with suspected COVID undergoing *continuous* aerosol-generating procedures, place in negative pressure isolation room (AIIR)

Transmission-Based Isolation options:

- Airborne Isolation:** pulmonary TB, measles
- Contact Isolation:** LR-VRE, CRE (CP gene detected), MDRO, *Candida auris*, infectious diarrhea (e.g., enterovirus, rotavirus)
- Enteric Contact Isolation:** *Clostridioides difficile*, norovirus, diarrhea (etiology unknown)
- Droplet Isolation:** URI (e.g., pertussis/parapertussis), *Neisseria meningitidis*
- Both **Contact** and **Droplet:** URI (e.g., RSV, adenovirus, etiology unknown)
- Both **Contact** and **Airborne:** varicella, disseminated shingles

Admission Order Sets for COVID-19 Screening

- Fever (objective or subjective)
- Myalgias
- Respiratory symptoms (dyspnea or cough)
- URI symptoms (headache, rhinorrhea, sore throat)
- GI symptoms (diarrhea, nausea, vomiting)
- ENT symptoms (loss of taste or smell)
- Eye symptoms (conjunctivitis)
- Other clinical concern for COVID-19 (petechiae, acral vasculitic changes, suggestive imaging (B peripheral groundglass opacities))

OR

- COVID-19 close contact (including household exposure, newborn with COVID-19 confirmed mother)
