# **UCSF Health Guidance for Discontinuing Isolation for <u>Select</u> Severely Immunocompromised COVID+ Patients**

#### Select severely immunocompromised

## All patients


- 1. Solid organ transplant recipient in the last year
- 2. Receiving rituximab or other B-cell depleting agents within the last 6 months
- 3. Primary immunodeficiencies combined immunodeficiencies (e.g. SCID/CVID),
- B-cell deficiencies and/or needing immunoglobulin replacement, idiopathic CD4
- lymphopenia/severe lymphopenia; but NOT CGD or most DiGeorge's syndrome

## a. Adult services

i. Adult AML/ALL until 3 months after completion of cytotoxic chemotherapy ii. Adult CAR-T cell and Allogeneic stem cell transplant within last 3 months

#### **b.** Pediatric services

- i. Patients with AML until 3 months after completion of chemotherapy ii. Patients with infant ALL and/or ALL patients not in remission iii. Patients with CAR-T cell therapy within the last 3 months
- iv. All BMT patients without T cell reconstitution



**Otherwise refer** to the general discontinuation guidance for COVID-19 positive patients

> COVID-19 positivity should not delay time-sensitive care
