

# Workflow Referral from Community PCP referral to UCSF Peds Respiratory Screening Clinic

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## Screening Questions and Risk Factors:

### Meets the following for considering testing:

- **Respiratory complaints plus any of the following:**
  - Fever (objective or subjective)
  - New cough or Dyspnea
  - Myalgias or flu like illness
  - Loss of taste or smell
  - Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
  - Other clinical concern for COVID-19 including conjunctivitis, petechiae, acral vasculitic rash
- **OR Mild respiratory symptoms** (rhinorrhea, congestions, sore throat, cough) plus risk factors **1,2,3**

### <sup>1</sup>**Environmental risks**

- High-risk travel or known COVID-19 exposure within 14 days
- High-risk setting (dormitory, outpatient dialysis, radiation oncology, infusion center)

### <sup>2</sup>**Patient-related risks**

- Immunocompromised (oncology, transplant, immunosuppressive meds, other known immunodeficiency)
- Chronic lung disease
- End stage renal disease
- Diabetes

### **Household high-risk contact**

- Age > 60 years
- Immunocompromised (oncology, transplant, immunosuppressive meds, HIV, other known immunodeficiency)
- Pregnancy
- Chronic lung disease
- Cirrhosis
- Cardiovascular disease
- End stage renal disease
- Diabetes
- Hypertension

Provider determines patient needs additional assessment (triage or in person visit) from Peds RSC at UCSF Mt. Zion



## Provider Refers patient to Peds RSC:

- Provider informs patient about referral to UCSF Peds RSC in San Francisco and gets patient to agree to visit.
- Provider calls (415) 885-7710 (NOT FOR PATIENTS) and asks to speak with Practice Supervisor Tselate Mussie. Provider provides name, DOB, parent/legal guardian name and phone number for patient.
- Provider indicates if visit is for initial triage or in person visit. If in person visit, provider faxes their note to (415) 885-3790.
- Provider places referral for Second Opinion or Visit at UCSF Pediatric Primary Care at Mt. Zion through insurance provider.
- UCSF Peds RSC contacts family to register and schedule patient for appropriate visit (telehealth for triage or in person visit)

## UCSF Peds RSC:

- Sees patient via telehealth and/or in person visit.
- Practice e-faxes note to PCP
- Follows up any testing results and signs out results to PCP.

## Pediatric Covid Test Result Team:

- **Negative Test**
  - Patient receives call with negative result
  - PCP/Referring Provider gets result through MD Link or Care Everywhere
- **Positive Test**
  - PCP/Referring Provider gets call with positive result. Also available through MD Link or Care Everywhere
  - Patient receives call with positive result from UCSF MD
  - Patient receives daily symptom check until day 14 from onset of symptoms from UCSF Pediatric Covid Test Result Team (*Can be declined by PCP*)
