Hands Full Procedure



Delivering Equipment to the Patient (newspapers, mail, laptops, toys etc)

Remember Hand Hygiene!

- **1.** Clean your hands
- 2. Pick up the item to be delivered
- 3. Knock on the door and introduce yourself
- 4. Walk in give the item to the patient or place the item on the table
- 5. As you walk out of the patient's room clean your hands
- 6. Pick up the item and repeat from #2 #6








Onto the next patient

Remember Hand Hygiene!


Cleaning your hands coming out of a room (A) and going into another patient's room (B) is counted as a "yes" exiting room A and a "yes" entering room B

•Do as directed by your supervisors and managers

•ALWAYS remember to clean your hands!



- Do not go from patient room to patient room wearing the same pair of gloves.
- Wear gloves for one task only ~ remove the gloves and clean your hands!
